Join the Riverside Symphonia this weekend for an unforgettable musical tour of Europe. Single tickets and subscriptions are still available for the 2007/2008 season. The first concert titled "Four Corners of Europe" features classical guitarist Marcin Dylla and will be held Friday, October 12 and Saturday, October 13, 2007 at 8pm in the Church of St. John the Evangelist in Lambertville, NJ.

Reduced price tickets of \$5 each are also being offered to students and parents of the New Hope-Solebury, Delaware Township, Lambertville Area and West Amwell Schools. Reduced price tickets are sponsored by The Riverside Symphonia's Educational Outreach program in collaboration with the Jonathan D. The musical tour begins in Great Britain, where Mendelssohn captured the sounds and atmosphere of the sea coast in "The Hebrides" and continues through Spain with internationally renowned guest artist Marcin Dylla's performance of "Concierto de Aranjuez". In dramatic musical contrast to the Spanish music will be the nostalgic "Valse Triste" by Jan Sibelius, a part of his musical setting to the Finnish drama "Kuolema". The concert ends in a splendid finale with one of Mozart's most brilliant symphonies, "Prague", named after the city whose people were so welcoming to him.
