## **Riverside Symphonia Concerts Bring Audiences to their Feet**

The culmination of the week was two concerts held in the Church of St. John the Evangelist. Each evening as Dylla ended his performance the audience leapt to its feet with resounding applause. Equally moved by this response he then delighted audiences with encores both evenings. Performances were followed by a reception held at Fiddleheads in Lambertville.
